Japan-Denmark Relations
Visit by Mr. Akira Amari, Minister in charge of Economic Revitalization
of Japan

Mr. Akira Amari, Minister in charge of Economic Revitalization of Japan will pay a working visit to Denmark from Friday, September 6 to Saturday, September 7. The minister is one of the core ministers to implement and execute Japanese economic policy and growth strategy.

During his stay in Denmark, the Minister is expected to make the following visits.

- Ministry of Economic Affairs and the Interior
- Ministry of Science, Innovation and Higher Education
- Ministry of Finance
- Medicon Valley Alliance
- Danish National Biobank
- Lolland Island

Mr. Toshio Sano, the Japanese Ambassador to Denmark, stressed in his statement that the visit of the Minister in charge of Economic Revitalization will play a key role in strengthening bilateral relations in the economic area and it will further contribute to economic growth on a global scale.
